Presentation Summary:

The Agile Manifesto was created in 2001 with the intent of helping software organization move away from process-first thinking and towards customer-first thinking. Fast forward to today and many organizations, regardless of industry or domain, are looking at how they can use Agile to help their businesses. Unfortunately many organizations see Agile as just another set of processes and once they define, standardize, and rollout these new processes, they're right back in the same state that they wanted to get out of in the first place.

In this session, we'll explore modern practises from agile, lean startup, and design thinking so we can be more intentional about changing how we manage work and people instead of blindly 'installing agile' because everyone else is doing it.

About the Speaker:

After studying electronic engineering, Jason moved to the IT sector to begin a career in programming when Cold Fusion roamed the earth. A few management jobs, and startup successes later, he moved into helping organizations change how they manage work and people with agile practices in the mid-2000s.

Jason is the author of Agile Transformation: A Guide for Organizational Change, and Lean Change Management: Innovative Practises for Managing Organizational Change. He founded the Lean Change Management Association in 2018, an organization dedicated to helping change agents use modern ideas and practises for transforming their organizations, and he designed the Agile Methodologies course for Sheridan College in 2013 which he continues teaching in his spare time.



Since the release of Lean Change Management in 2014, Jason has traveled to over 10 countries delivering workshops based on the book, and speaking at various private and public events to help inspire people to change how they think about changing their organization.
